YATC celebrates 25 years of keeping kids in the car tracks

When the Youth Automotive Training Center opened its doors in 1984, Founder **Jim Moran** had a vision: YATC would give troubled kids training in automotive repair. He instinctively knew that over time YATC could offer more. YATC developed a unique approach to helping at-risk youth steer their lives away from violence, drugs and crime onto a path leading to success, fulfillment and an honest living.

What began in a one-room building in Hollywood, Florida, is now a 16,000 square foot, state-of-the-art training center in Deerfield Beach, Florida, with 491 graduates and a success rate of more than 90 percent. YATC's program continues to provide technical automotive education, but also offers remedial academic instruction, high school equivalency diploma preparation, career counseling and life management skills, along with a healthy dose of caring — a life-changing combination that Jim Moran envisioned from the start. For **Joel Garcia**, a 2009 YATC graduate, it was.

"I'm grateful for the time YATC instructors and staff gave me," Garcia said, "and for providing me with a second home — a place I could come to every day with a purpose."

Graduate Spotlight: Kevin Butler, Class of 1999

In 1998, opportunity knocked on Kevin Butler's door. Born in Kingston, Jamaica, Butler emigrated to the United States with his family when he was 12 years old. He graduated from Boyd Anderson High School in 1995 and attended BETA Center, a neighborhood outreach program for at-risk youth and their families in Broward County. But his life was not what he imagined. He was looking for more. At that point, desperate for a change, Butler discovered a once-in-a-lifetime chance to redirect his life — YATC.

Butler always enjoyed working with his hands and he hoped tinkering with cars could become more than a hobby. At YATC, he learned from technical instructor and YATC graduate Charles Whitehouse. Many guest speakers inspired Butler, and the frequent visits from Founder Jim Moran gave him the courage to strive for more in his life.

"He [Mr. Moran] would tell us that he was also in a similar situation one time in his life," Butler recalled. "I realized that he started out with nothing yet built a great empire. For me, this was the hope I needed to hear so that I could work hard to get

that pot of gold at the end of the rainbow."

After graduation, Butler became a technician at National Tire and Battery (NTB) and then was hired by NTB's parent company, Sears, to work in its automotive department. For the past eight years, Butler has worked at Tires Plus, a full-service car center.

As Butler looks back on his YATC experience, he has some advice for new students.

"There is opportunity waiting for you at YATC," he said. "If you want to make something of yourself, ask the questions, use the knowledge and take the help that's given. In the end, you'll realize, too, there is a pot of gold if you work hard to get it."

making the YATC program meaningful for each student.

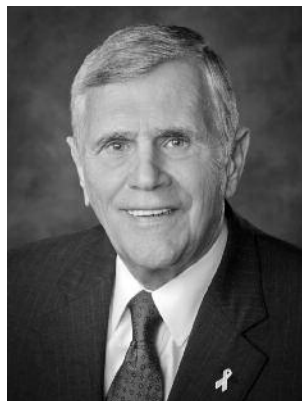
"The important thing is they see themselves as winners," Stallings said. "As winners they can do anything."

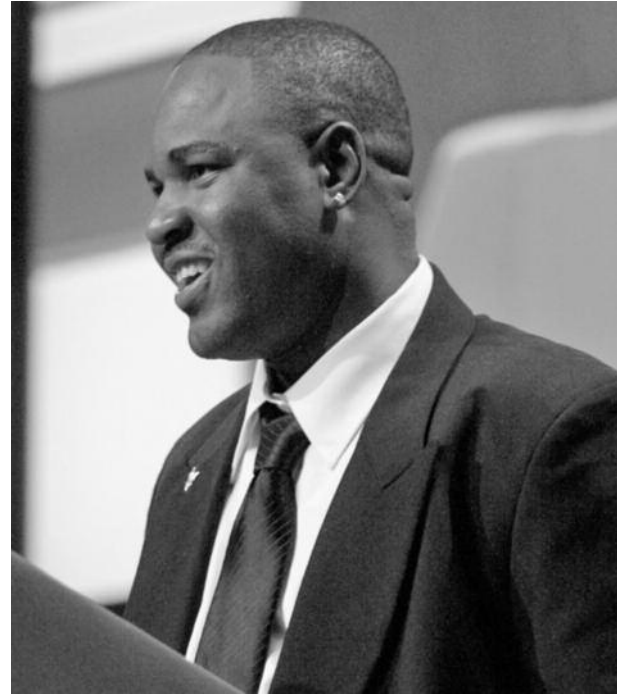
2008 Jim Moran Classic gives kids a jump start in life

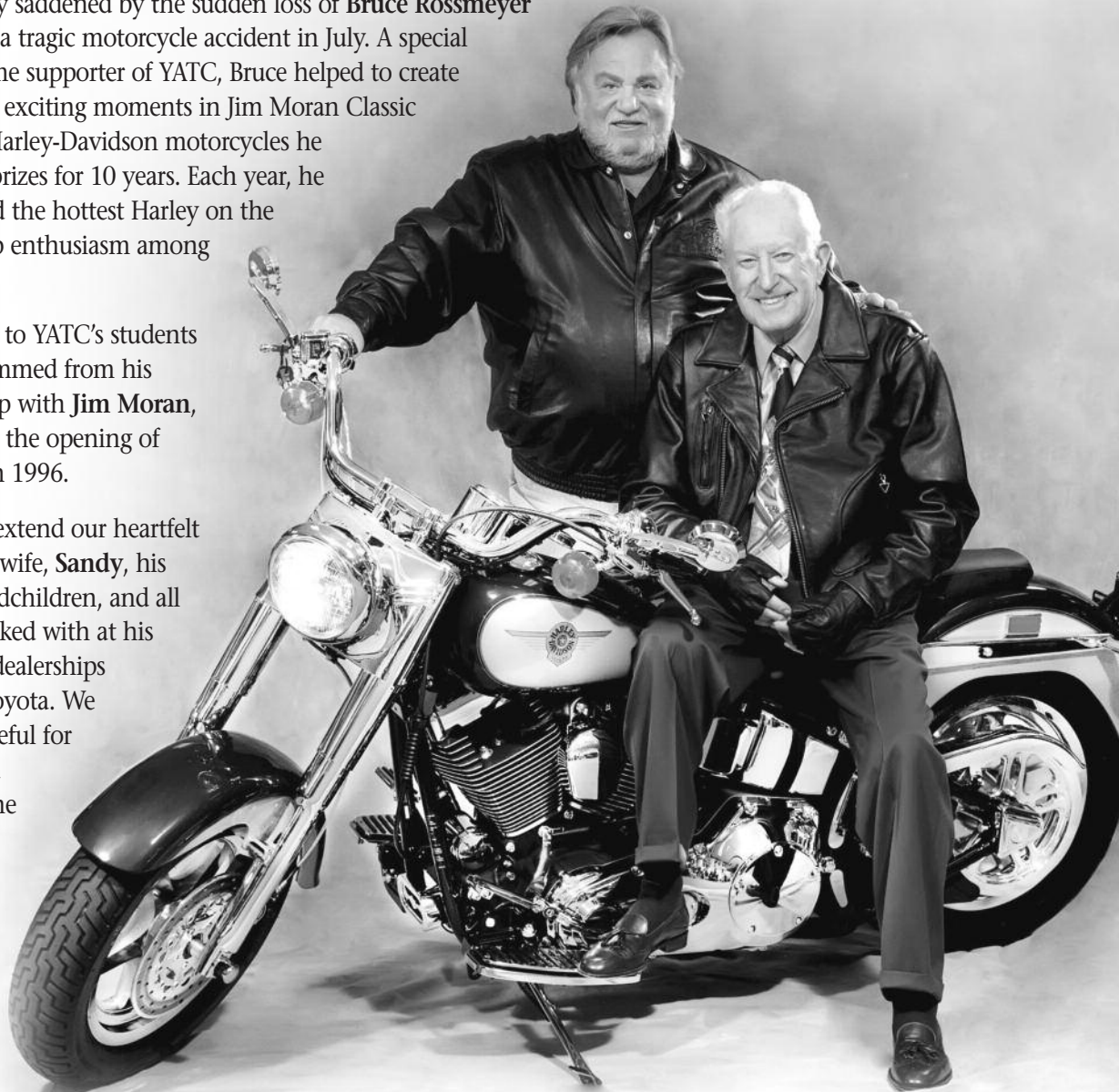
Bruce's dedication to YATC's students and graduates stemmed from his personal friendship with **Jim Moran**, which began with the opening of Daytona Toyota in 1996.

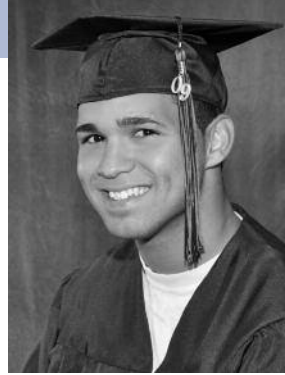

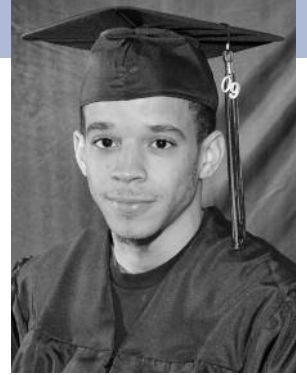

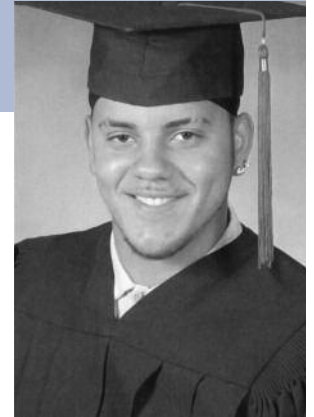

Class 31 students embark on YATC journey

YATC welcomed the 30 members of the Class of 2010 this fall. Here are some facts about our current students:

- This year YATC received more than 150 referrals, more than 140 applications and interviewed 105 applicants
- The average student age is 18.83 years (youngest student is 16 years; oldest students are 21 years)
- In the current class, 6% dropped out of middle school, 64% dropped out of high school and 10% were expelled
- 17% of the students have a GED and 3% have a high school diploma
- The average academic level tested (according to TABE standard test): reading is 8.5, math is 7.4 and language is 6.2
- 20% of current students have children
- 73% of Class 31 students have arrest records
- 27% have a history of possession/sale of controlled substance
- 83% have current and/or past drug use issues
- 30% are currently on probation
